Pedro Pita Barros is Professor of Economics at Universidade Nova de Lisboa. He is a member of the European Commission's "Expert panel on effective ways of investing in health", a member of the Portuguese National Council of Ethics for the Life Sciences, a member of Portuguese National Health Council and Past-President of the European Association of Health Economics.

His research focuses on health economics and on regulation and competition policy and appeared in many academic journals. Pedro Pita Barros has also several books on health economics (in Portuguese and English).

He served as Member of the Board of the Portuguese Energy Regulator (2005/2006) and on the Governmental Commission for the Financial Sustainability of the National Health Service (2006/2007). Pedro Pita Barros was President of the Portuguese Association for Health Economics.

He serves on the editorial boards of academic journals in the field of Health Economics. He acted as consultant for both private and public entities, in Portugal and at the European level, in the areas of health economics, competition policy and economic regulation.
